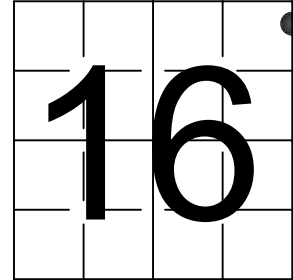

June 20, 1903 - Surveyors: L. Kleinschmidt and Herman Rusch - indicate they set a stone at this position on Map M56B.

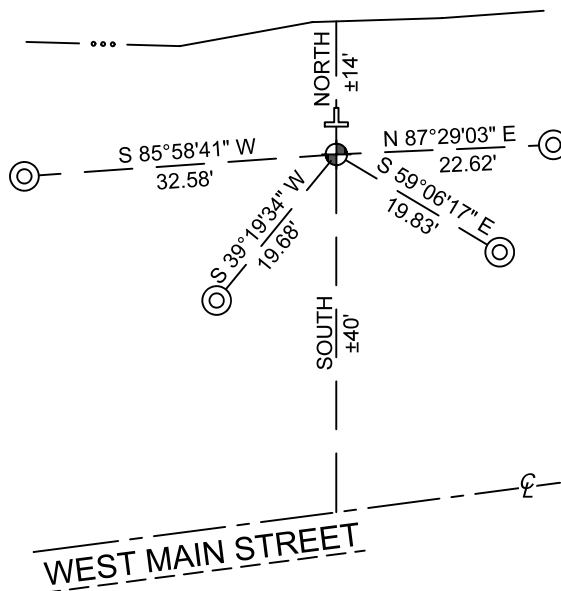
April 19, 2022 - While performing the 2022 Lincoln County PLSS Corner Remonumentation and GPS Services project, I found a 2.5" diameter iron pipe near the computed position provided by Lincoln County. The monument is ± 14 feet south of the south bank of the Wisconsin River, and between 2 storm sewer culverts. I established 4 new reference monuments as shown below.

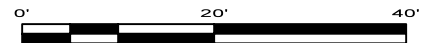


## WISCONSIN RIVER

- 7/8" diameter X 30" long - iron rod with 2" diameter aluminum cap, set
- Vinyl T-post, set ±1.25 feet north of corner



A-E 7.08(3)(e) 1852 Surveyor set a post, 1903 Surveyor set a stone, I found a 2.5" diameter iron pipe.

A-E 7.08(3)(f) I accept this monument as a FOUND PERPETUATED LOCATION of the corner.

A-E 7.08(3)(g)(h) This corner was not determined through lost-corner-proportionate methods.

A-E 7.08(3)(i) I, Jeffrey L. DeMuth, Professional Land Surveyor No. S-2656, hereby certify that the corner location on this record was determined by the Lincoln County Surveyor, and the monuments found or set as shown hereon were measured by me or under my direction and control, and that this U.S. Public Land Survey Monument Record is correct and complete to the best of my knowledge, and belief.
