of November 1917, the following application to lay out and construct a highway on Section in said Town, was presented, to-wit:

To the Supervisors of the Town of Harrison in Lincoln County, Wis.:

We, the undersigned, nine freeholders, and applicants for homesteads under the laws of the United States, occupying the same, residing in said Town of Harrison, do hereby make application to you to lay out and construct a highway in said Town as follows:

Beginning at the section corner of Sec 7 and 18 Townships 35 Range 8 on the west side of said Town Running then East a 1/2 mile, then North eighty rods to 1/8 post on the south 1/8 line of Sec 7. Then east on said 1/8 line as far as possible on said line about 1/2 mile, then on a North Easterly course to the North 1/8 line of Sec 8 - 35-8, to connect with road build on said line

Beginning at the Section corner of Sec. 7 and 18th 35th R. 8. on the west side of said town, run then east 1/2 mile then north 80 rods to 1/8 post on the South 1/8 line of Sec 7. Then east on said 1/8 line as far as possible on said line about 1/2 mile then on a North Easterly course to the North 1/8 line of sec. 8 - 35-8 to connect with road now build on said line.

Notice is therefore hereby given that we, the undersigned Supervisors of said Town, will meet on the 20th day of Nov. 1917, at 10 o'clock in the fore noon of that day, at F Cleveland's house in said Town, and decide upon such application.
