We, the undersigned, Supervisors of the Town of Harrison, in the County of Sinclair, having by an order bearing date the \_\_\_\_\_ day of June 1923, upon due application for that purpose, to construct a highway as follows:

*Commencing at a point on Bass Lake Road

between Marys Lake and Mull Lake  
Being situated on lot 2 Section 10 Town  
34 Range 8 East*

and the following named owners of lands through which such highway is Being Built & constructed not having released all claim to damages sustained by reason of the construction of said highway, and the undersigned not being able to agree with such owners as to the amount of such damages, having applied to them for that purpose, and endeavored to make such agreement, we, the said Supervisors, did at the time of making said order, ascertain and assess the damages which such owners will severally sustain by reason of the construction of such highway through their lands, and having taken into consideration the benefits which each owner aforesaid may receive thereby, we determine and award such damages as follows, to-wit:
