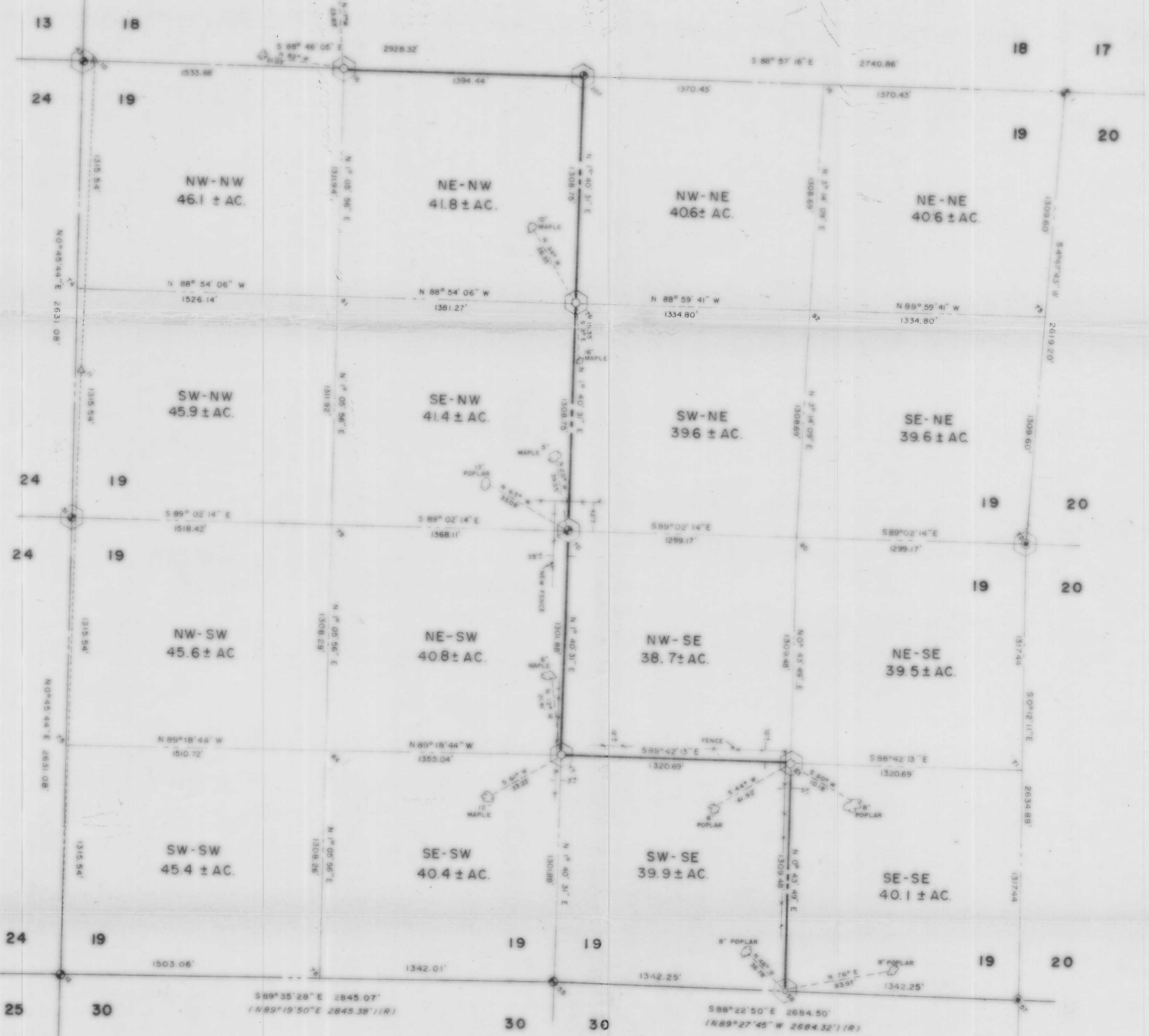

 - Iron pin (3/8" hole, cone, nail, 60/ nail, etc)
 - set as temporary survey point
 - Computer (coordinate) point number
 - Random survey traverse line
 - (R) Previously recorded bearing or distance
- All distances are to the nearest 0.01 ft.
 All angular measurements have been made to the nearest 10" and computed to the nearest 0.5".
 All bearings are referenced to the East line of the 36 of Sec. 19-35-4E, assumed as S 0° 12' 30" E.
