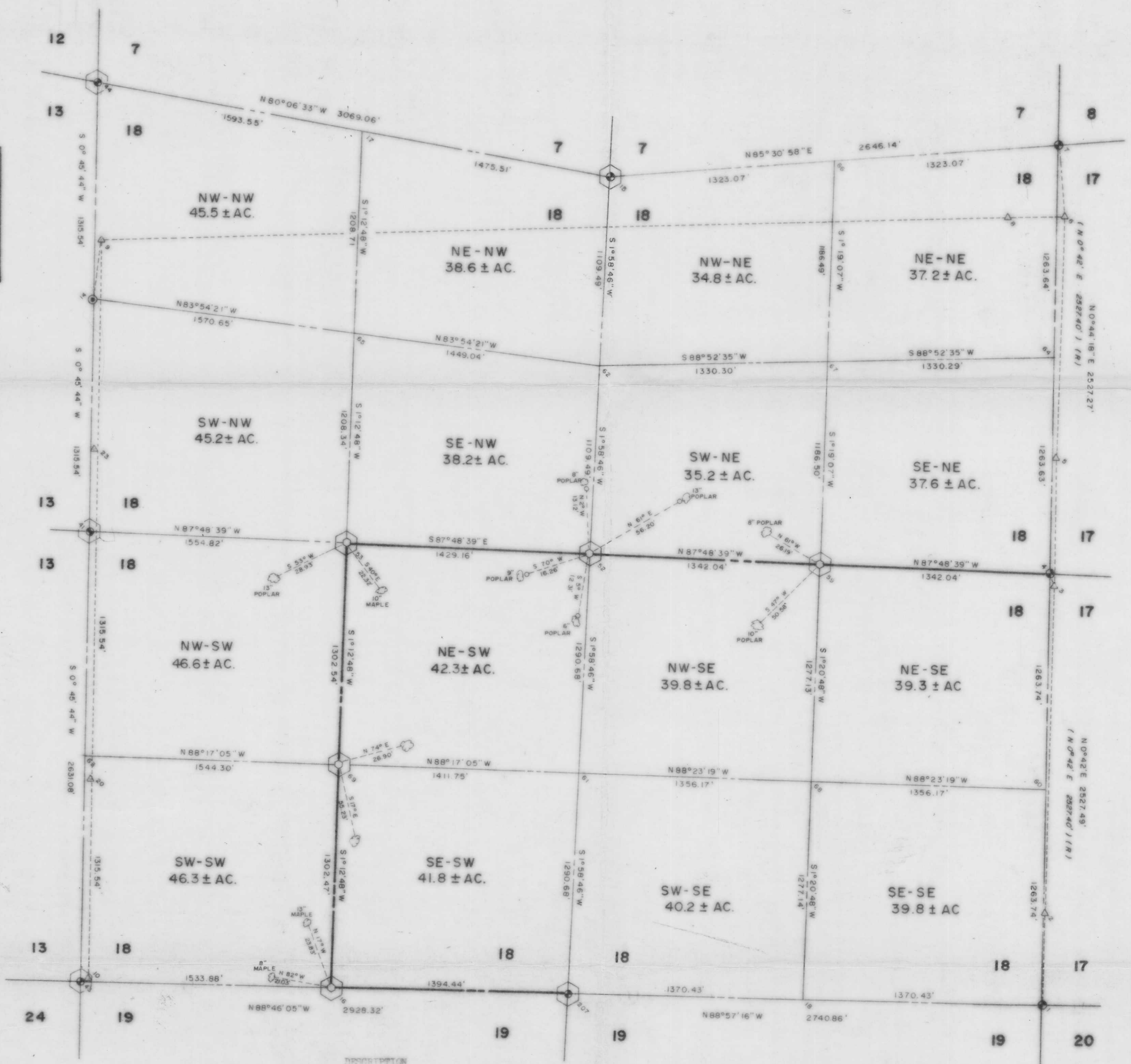


SECTION 18, T. 35 N., R. 4 E., LINCOLN COUNTY, WIS.
