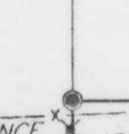

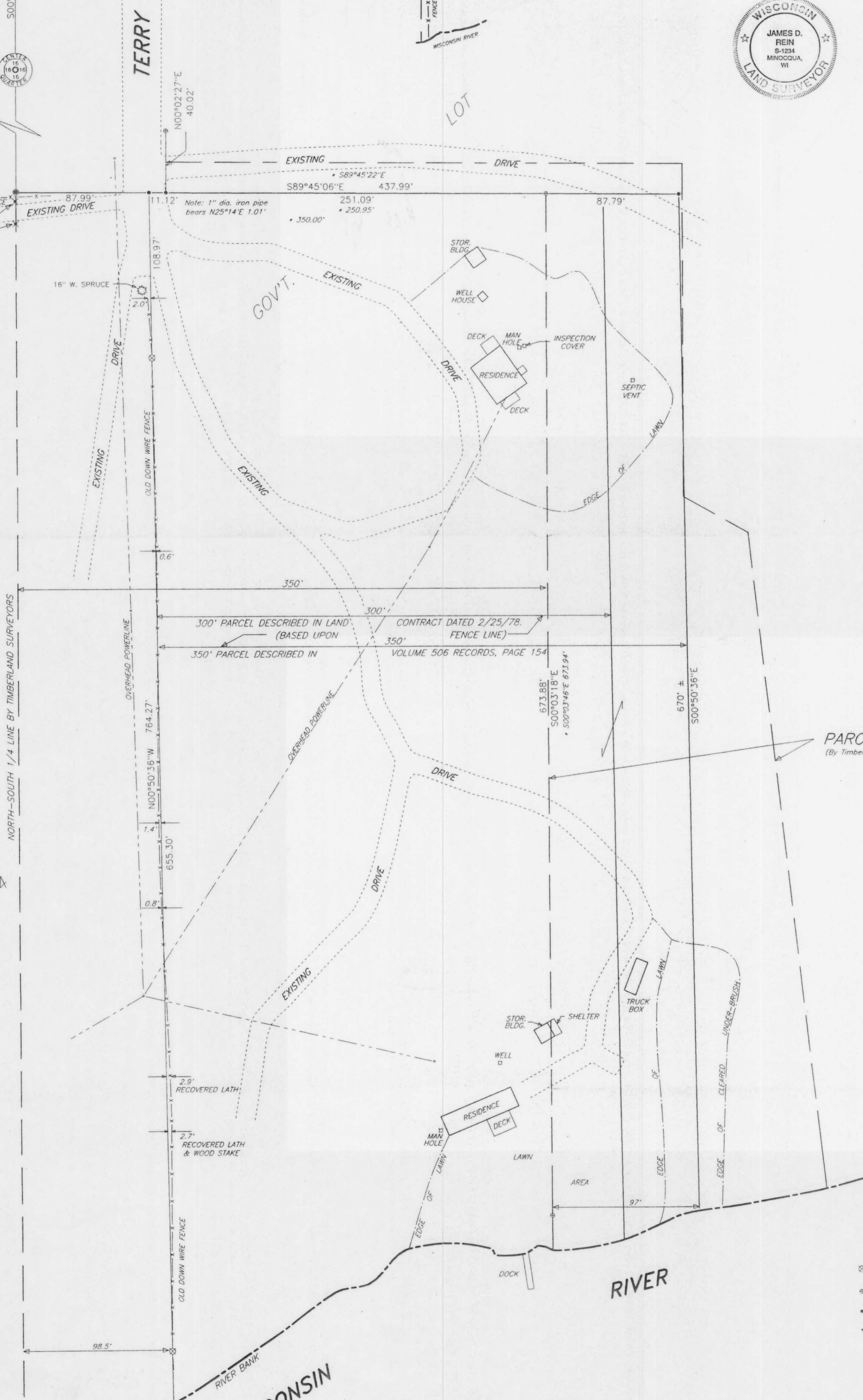

NORTH-SOUTH 1/4 LINE BY TIMBERLAND SURVEYORS

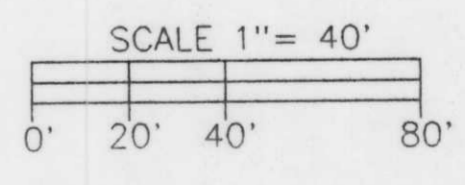

Commencing at the North Quarter Corner of said Section 16, thence South 00 degrees 04 minutes 01 seconds East (True Bearing) for a distance of 2630.24 feet to the Center Quarter Corner as established by Timberland Surveyors, marked by an iron pipe; thence South 00 degrees 03 minutes 17 seconds East for a distance of 1316.01 feet to the Center-South Sixteenth Corner as established by Timberland Surveyors, marked by an iron pipe; thence South 89 degrees 45 minutes 06 seconds East for a distance of 87.99 feet to the place of beginning.

Thence continuing South 89 degrees 45 minutes 06 seconds East for a distance of 350.00 feet; thence South 00 degrees 50 minutes 36 seconds East for a distance of 670 feet more or less to the northerly bank of the Wisconsin River; thence Southwesterly along the said northerly bank to an intersection with a southerly extension of an old down wire fence; thence North 00 degrees 50 minutes 36 seconds West for a distance of 800 feet more or less to the place of beginning.

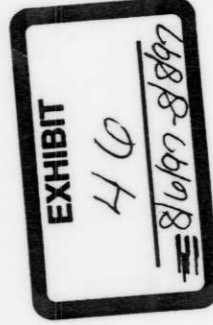
