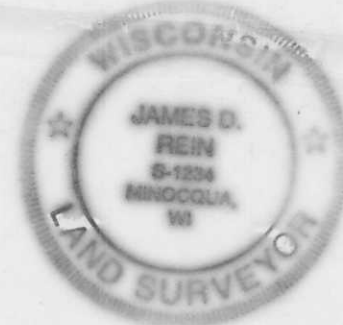

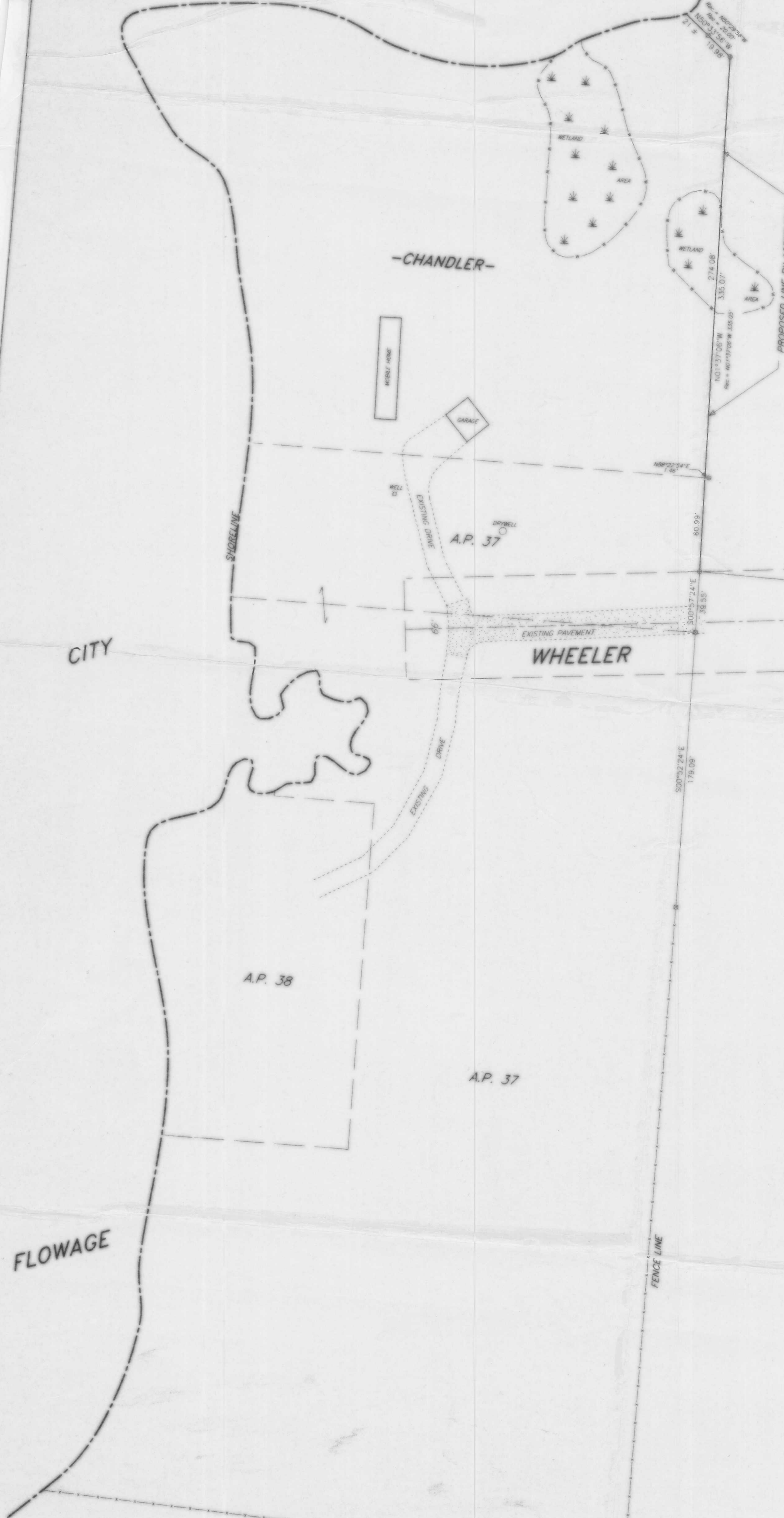

CHANDLER/PETERSEN - LINE BY AGREEMENT

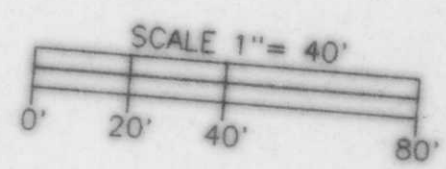
A line by agreement located in Government Lot 7, Section 28, Township 35 North, Range 6 East, City of Tomahawk, Lincoln County, Wisconsin, being shown on Map No. 96-169 by Wilderness Surveying, Inc., dated July 2nd, 1997, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the quarter corner common to Section 21 and Section 28, marked by a 4" dia. aluminum monument, thence South 00 degrees 04 minutes 14 seconds West for a distance of 1326.63 feet along the north-south quarter line to the Center-North Sixteenth Corner, marked by an iron bar; thence North 89 degrees 24 minutes 37 seconds West for a distance of 994.38 feet to the place of beginning of said line, being the southwesterly corner of that parcel of land described in Volume 518 of Records, on page 92, marked by an iron pipe on the northerly right of way of Wheeler Road.

Thence North 01 degrees 37 minutes 06 seconds West for a distance of 335.07 feet along the westerly line of that parcel of land described in Volume 518 of Records, on page 92 to an iron pipe; thence continuing along the westerly line of said parcel of land described in Volume 518 of Records, on page 92 North 50 degrees 33 minutes 56 seconds West for a distance of 19.98 feet to an iron pipe near the southerly shore of the Jersey City parcel of land described in Volume 518 of Records, on page 92 North 50 degrees 33 minutes 56 seconds West a distance of 21 feet more or less to the ordinary high water mark of the Jersey City Flowage and there terminating.
