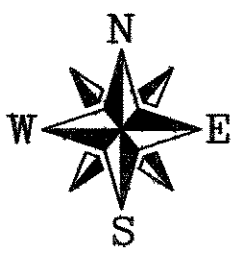


Plat of Survey

Part of the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 20, and part of the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 29; all being located in T.35N., R.6E., Town of Bradley, Lincoln County, Wisconsin

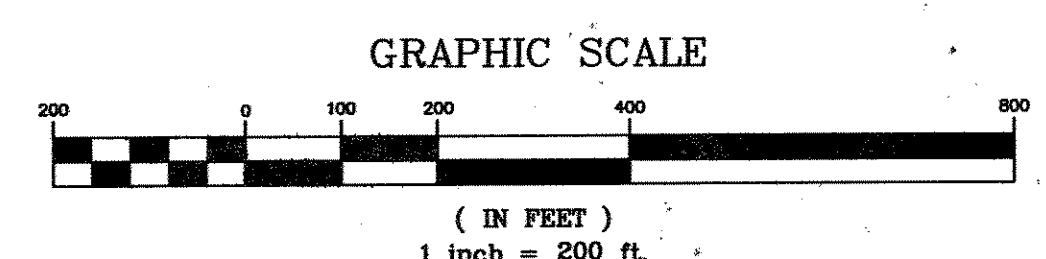

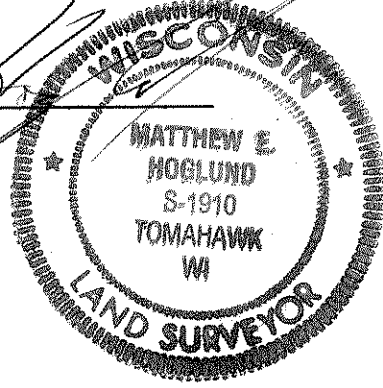
- A legal description for "This Parcel" shown hereon was provided to the client on a separate sheet.
- "This Parcel" shown hereon is being conveyed along with approximately 50 acres of adjoining property being the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 and the East 330 feet of the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 20 and cannot be sold separately unless approved by the Town of Bradley and Lincoln County in accordance with all applicable subdivision regulations.
- A written waiver, in accordance with Chapter A-E 7(2)(a)(b)(c)(d)(e) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code, was executed between Nicolet Surveyors, Inc. and Jim Barnhart, client, relative to the found monuments at Points "A" and "B" shown hereon. As the project budget would not allow a full survey of Section 20, which would include field measurements to additional 1/8 and 1/16 monuments from the 1966 Owens Illinois survey, the subdivision of Section 20 shown was calculated based on the published Lincoln County coordinate values noted at the North and West 1/4 corners to give a gross error check on the corner positions of the found monuments at Points "A" and "B" from the 1966 survey. Since the monuments fell within less than 5 feet of the calculated positions, and have been in place for over 40 years, the client requested we flag and mark the lines between the found monuments at Points "A", "B" and "C" shown. The client is fully aware that these corners and the lines marked between them may be approximate in nature, due to the reasons stated above.

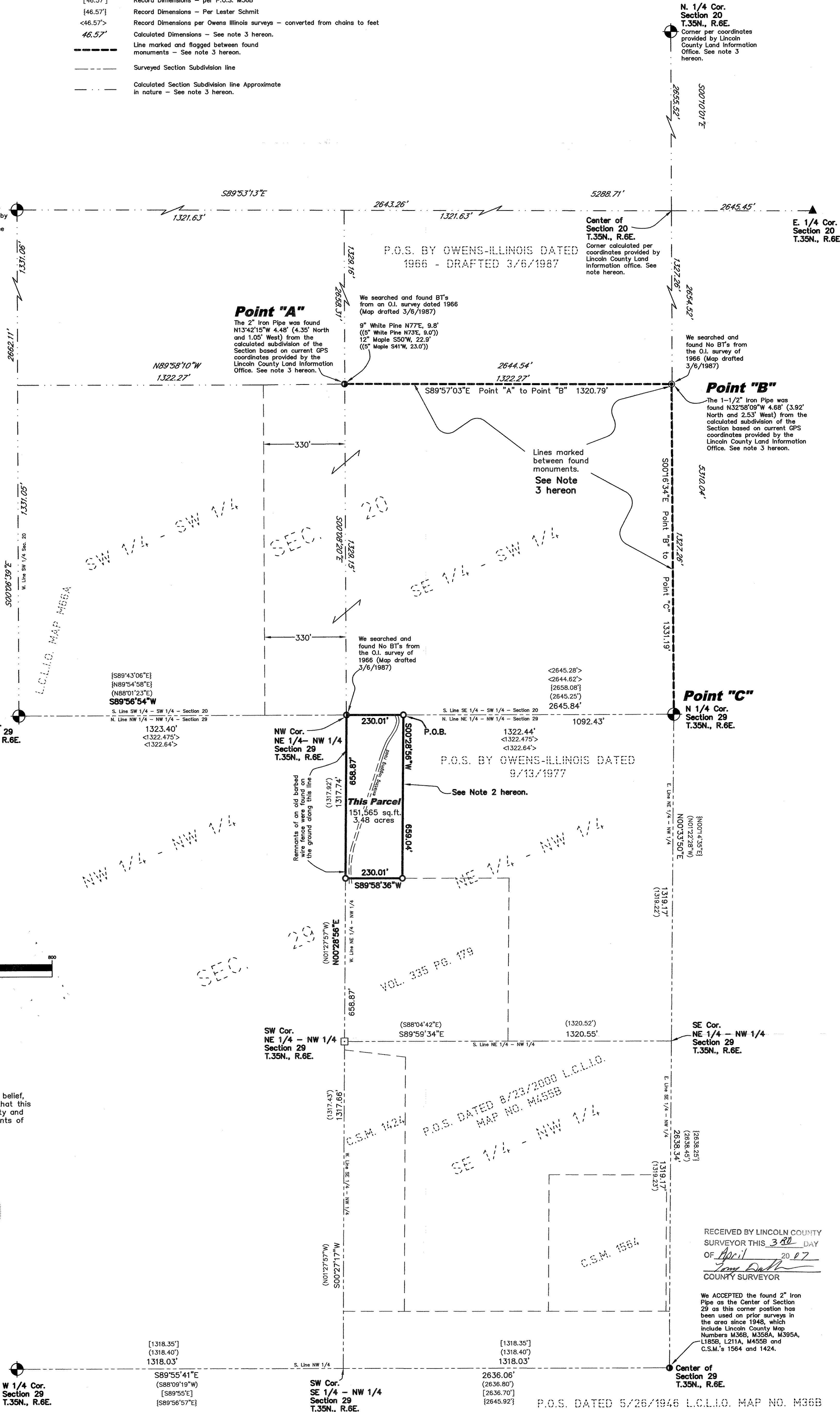
