I, Ray H. Hall do hereby certify that in October 1934 I surveyed the two tracts of land in the city of Tomahawk, lying West of the Chicago, Milwaukee and St Paul Ry. and North of Somo Avenue being a part of Govt. Lots 7 & C, Section 33, of T. 35 N. - R. 6 E. and known as the Raymond Tract, and the Tomahawk Steel & Iron Works. That in October 1935 I surveyed the 11 Acre tract west of and adjoining the aforesaid survey: That the map hereon is a correct representation of the three tracts, comprising all that portion of Lots 7 & C, Section 33, North by the flowage on the South by Somo Avenue, on the East by the Chicago, Milwaukee and St Paul Ry., and on the West by the right of way of the Tomahawk and Western Ry., and totaling 36.94 Acres. That this map is a correct and to supersede my map dated Nov. 6th, 1934. The line of Somo Avenue, determined by occupation as herein shown, deflects 0° 32' North-westerly from the line of Somo Avenue in the original plat of the West line of Railway Street.
