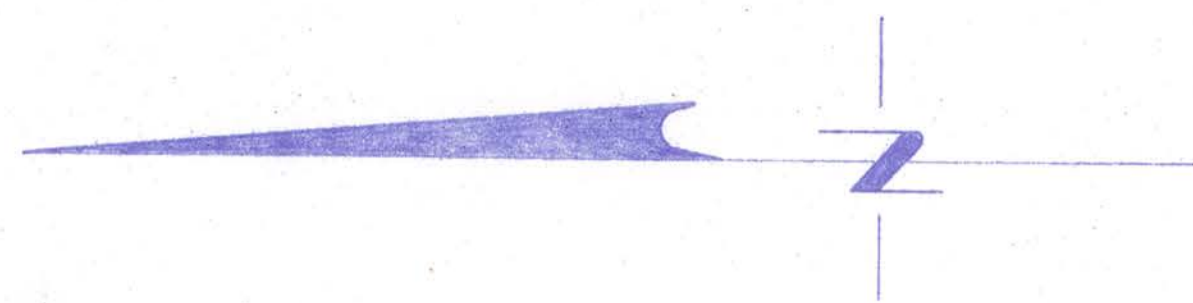

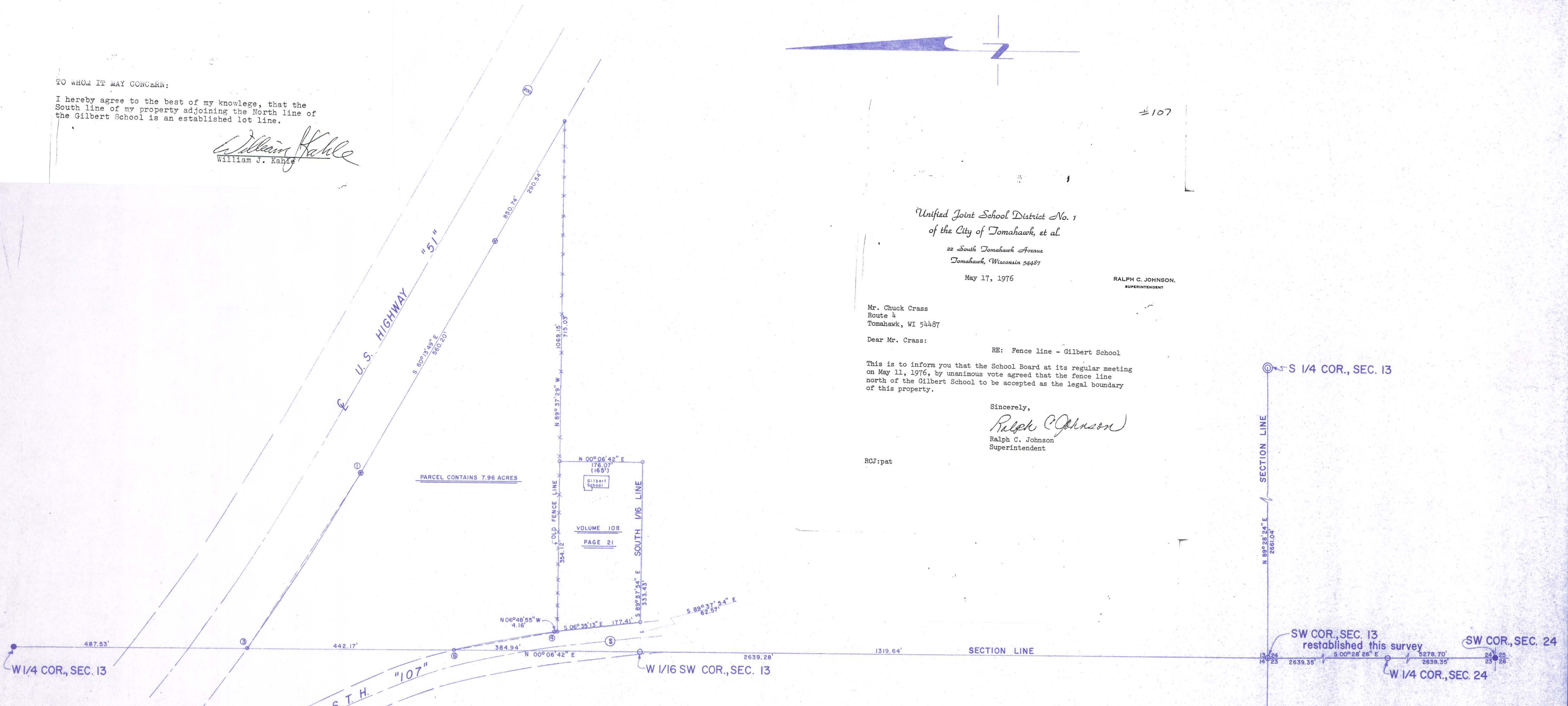
RE: Fence line - Gilbert School

NOTE

The recorded distance of the north-south line in Volume 108, page 21 is 10 rods or 165'. See attached sheets to this map for the reasoning to this map's distance. These 2 sheets are a letter from the Unified Joint School District No. 1 of the City of Tomahawk, et al. to Mr. Chuck Crass, dated May 17, 1976 and a signed statement by William J. Kahle, who was the owner of all the lands in the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4, lying southerly of then U.S. Highway #51, excepting said Volume 108, page 21. Mr. Kahle then sold the 7.96 acre parcel as shown hereon, to the Town of Bradley by Volume 337, page 89, Document No. 243765. Mr. Kahle still owns the property easterly of Volume 108, page 21.

I, Lester J. Schmit, Registered Land Surveyor S-1192 hereby certify that I have surveyed the property shown hereon; that this map is a true and accurate representation thereof; that said survey was performed by order of the Town of Bradley and Kevin Roth (Chairman); and that I have complied with applicable requirements of s. A-E 7 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code.
