
Commencing at the most southwesterly corner of Lot 13 Block 3 shown in Parcel 2 of Certified Survey Map No.341 LCR being a 1" iron pipe on the westerly line of said Lot 13; thence 8 75° 17' 47" W a distance of 105.53 feet to a set 1" iron bar on the easterly line of Lot 10 Block 3 of the flat of Camp Rice Point said point being 30.00 feet from the shore line of Lake Nokomis and is the POINT OF BEGINNING of this description; thence North along the easterly line of Lot 10 a distance of 368.15 feet to a set 1" iron bar on the southerly right-of-way of Camp Rice Point Road; thence 8 69° 26' 36" W along said right-of-way a distance of 13.87 feet; thence 8 69° 54' 35" W along said right-of-way a distance of 13.40 feet; thence 8 85° 07' 56" W along said right-of-way a distance of 9.11 feet to a set 1" iron bar on the westerly line of Lot 7 Block 3 of said plat; thence, leaving said right-of-way, South along the westerly line of Lot 7 a distance of 193.62 feet to a set 1" iron bar 30.00 feet from the shore of Lake Nokomis; thence 8 50° 00° 05" E along a line 30.00 feet distant from the shore of Lake Nokomis; thence 8 67° 24' 29" E along a line 30.00 feet from the shore of Lake Nokomis a distance of 110.91 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.


