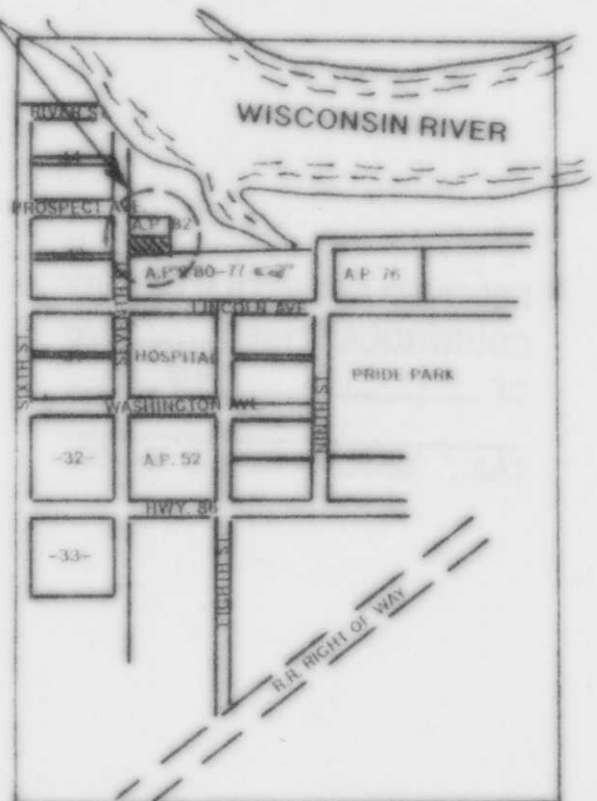

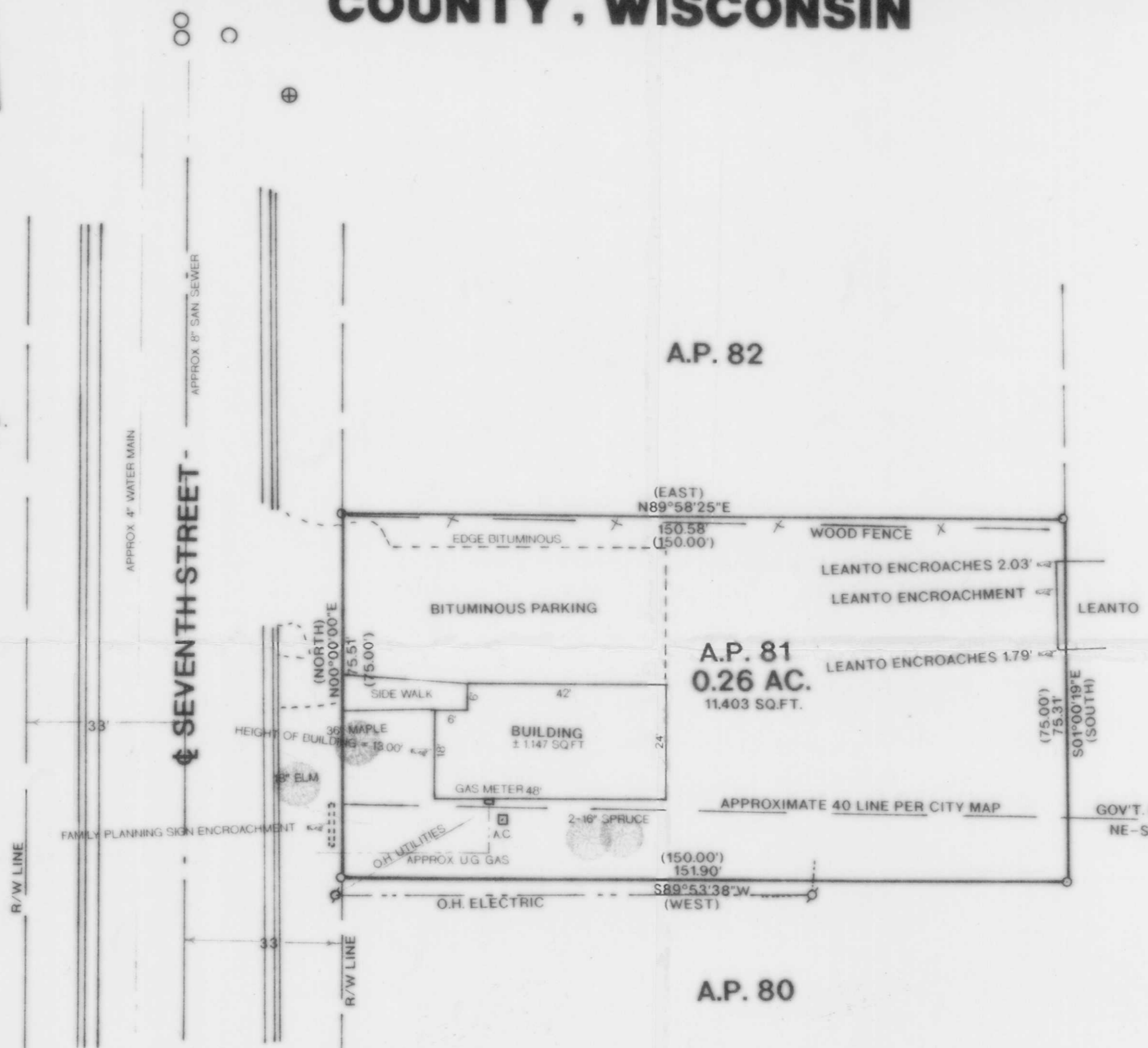
## LOCATION SKETCH
