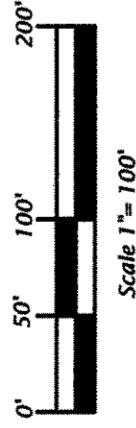


Bearing base assumed, referenced to the east line of the Northwest Quarter bearing, S00°17'11"W

Parcel -A- (Map No. 07-09)

That parcel of land previously described in Volume 500, on page 569, being located in the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter, Section 22, Township 35 North, Range 5 East, Wilson Township, Lincoln County, Wisconsin, being parcel "A-" shown on Map No. 07-09 by Oestreich Surveying & Mapping, LLC, dated March 28th, 2007, more accurately described as follows:

Commencing at the north quarter corner of Section 22, marked by the base of an aluminum monument in the northerly shoulder of County Highway "CC"; thence S00°17'11"W 1293.65 feet to the Center North Sixteenth Corner, marked by an iron pipe; thence continuing S00°17'11"W 707.56 feet along the east line of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter to the place of beginning, marked by an iron rod.

Thence continuing S00°17'11"W 297.03 feet along the east line of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter to an iron rod; thence N89°19'46"W 96.88 feet to an iron rod on the westerly right of way line of Poplar Drive; thence continuing N89°19'46"W 480.58 feet to an iron rod near the easterly bank of the Little Somo River; thence meandering along the river N08°44'05"E 372.00 feet to an iron pipe; thence N61°30'31"E 214.47 feet to an intersection with the northerly edge of a private road and the southerly line of that parcel of land described in Volume 397, on page 278, marked by an iron pipe; thence along said northerly edge and southerly line S43°10'28"E 60.86 feet to an iron pipe; thence continuing along said northerly edge and southerly line along a 615.00 radius curve to the left, 155.22 feet and being subtended by a chord of S50°24'17"E 154.81 feet to an iron rod; thence continuing along said northerly edge and southerly line S57°38'07"E 75.22 feet to an iron rod; thence continuing along said northerly edge and southerly line N76°45'44"E 15.45 feet to an iron rod on the westerly right of way line of Poplar Drive; thence continuing along the southerly line of that parcel of land described in Volume 397, on page 278 N89°58'10"E 94.42 feet to the place of beginning.

The above lateral lot lines extend to the bank of the Little Somo River, and include all lands lying between the meander line and the ordinary high water mark.

Subject to the rights of the public for that portion of the above described parcel of land lying within the right of way of Poplar Drive.

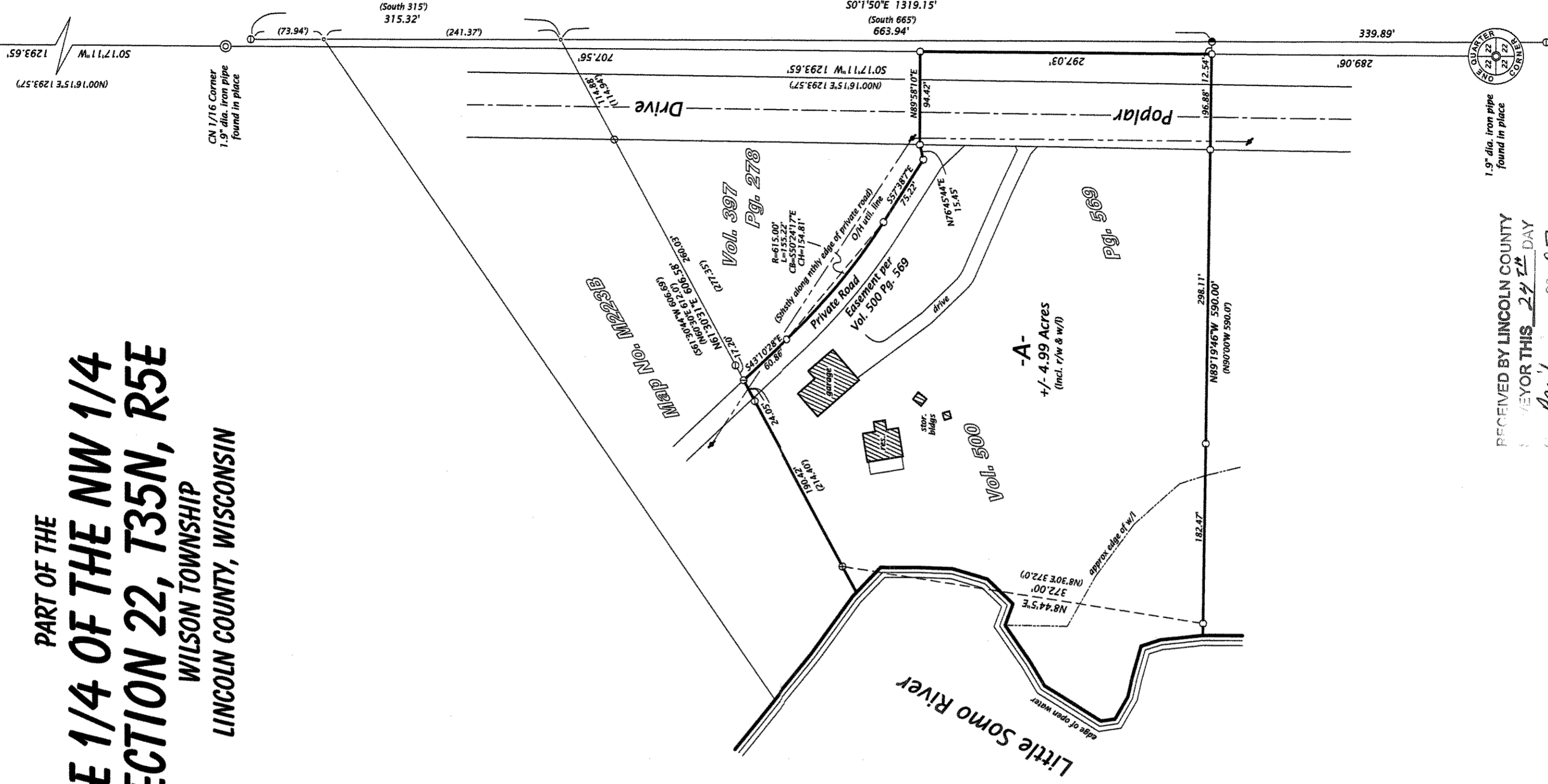

Said parcel contains 4.99 Acres more or less, including Poplar Drive and wetland area.

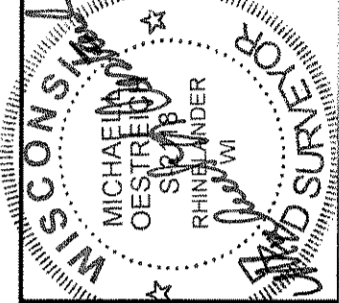
