We, the Town Board of Supervisors of said Town, and Louis Kleinschmidt, one of the Surveyors who made the annexed map and signed the Certificate thereto attached, dated June 20th, 1903, (the other surveyor, Herman Rusch, being now deceased), do hereby certify that having lately learned that the Town of Maine, in Marathon County, Wisconsin, which joins Section 32, Township 31 North, Range 7 East, on the south, claimed that the land mark shown on said Map as locating the quarter post in the south line of said Section is incorrect, and is located 34 feet too far north, we re-surveyed said line on the 16th day of November, 1925, and found that the claim of said Town of Maine is correct, and we accordingly moved said original land mark 34 feet south, where we established the same, and we certify further that the same is now correctly located and established at said quarter post.
