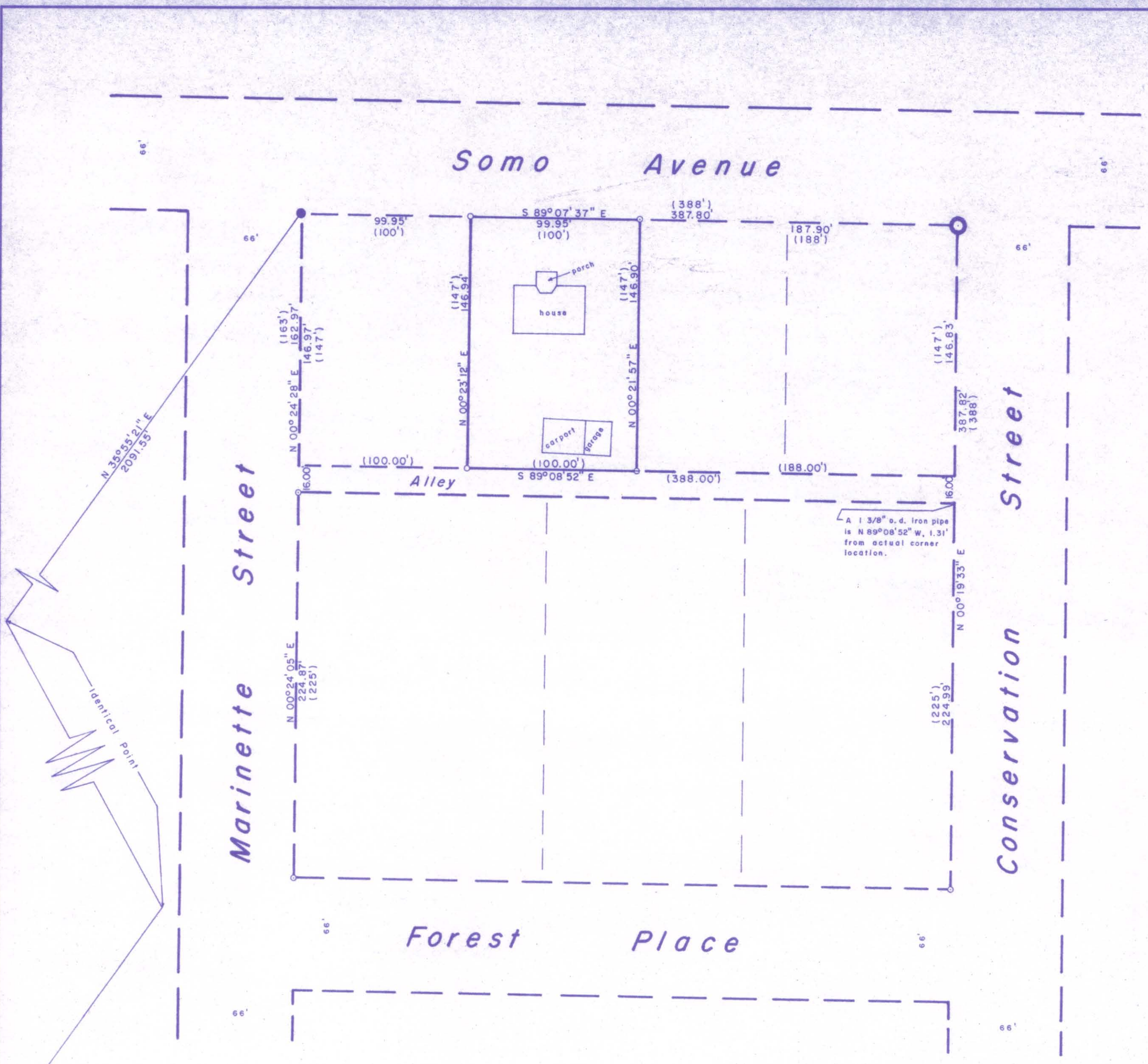

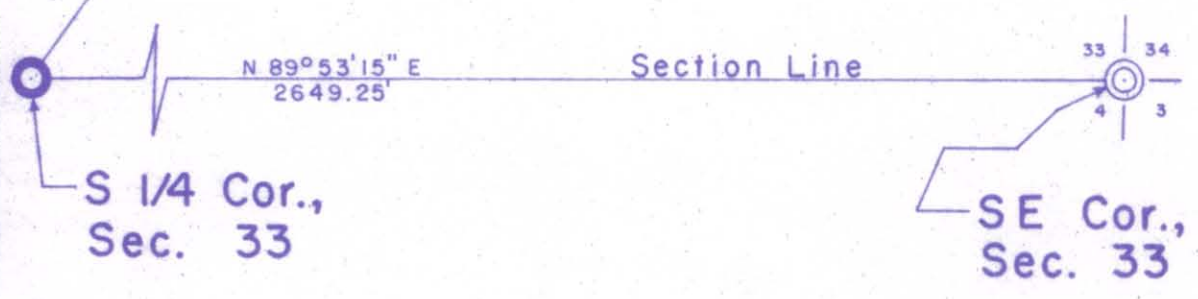

North is referenced to the south line of Section 33, which is N 89°53'15" E, per the Lincoln County Coordinate System.



NOTE

A survey of this area was done by Ray H. Hall in October 1934. On Assessor's Plat 91, of the City of Tomahawk, recorded on 4 September 1936, the same distance calls were shown as those on the Hall survey map. I therefore used a single proportion to determine the distances between the existing block corners along Somo Avenue for the lots.
