

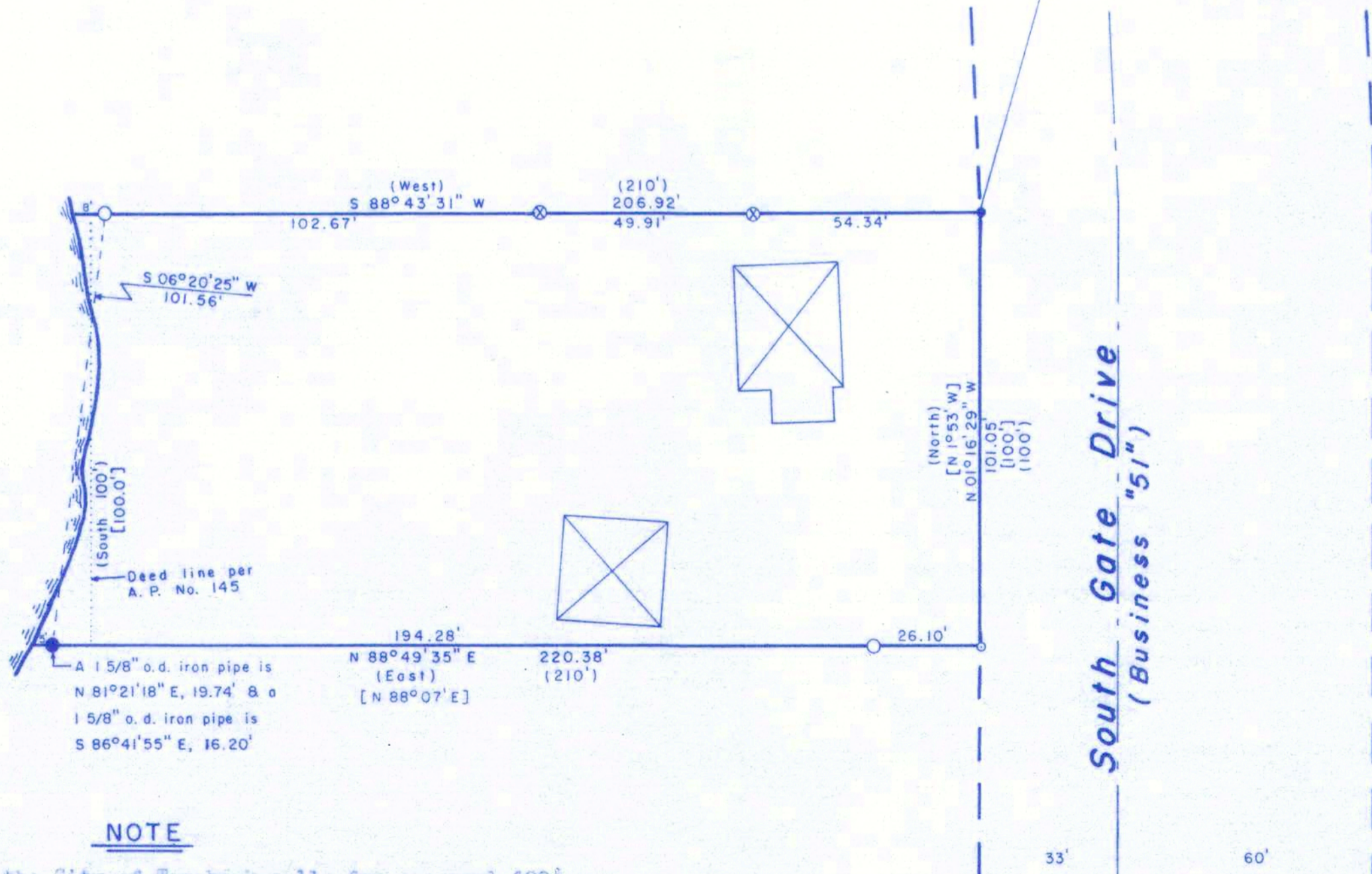

NOTE

A.P. # 145, to the City of Tomahawk calls for a parcel 100' north and south by 210' east and west. Using a survey and map by Louis W. Lembcke dated 7-18-67 for Gregory Smith of said A.P. # 145, in the Lincoln County Surveyor's records and s. 30.10 (4)(b) of the Wisconsin Statutes which states in part: "The boundaries of lands adjoining waters and the rights of the state and of individuals with respect to all such lands and waters shall be determined in conformity to the common law so far as applicable," "the owner is conclusively presumed to own to the actual shorelines." Based on the above information, I have mapped and shown hereon, said A.P. # 145 as having total and continuous frontage to Bullhead Pond (a natural lake), from the northerly to the southerly lines thereof, with riparian rights thereto.
