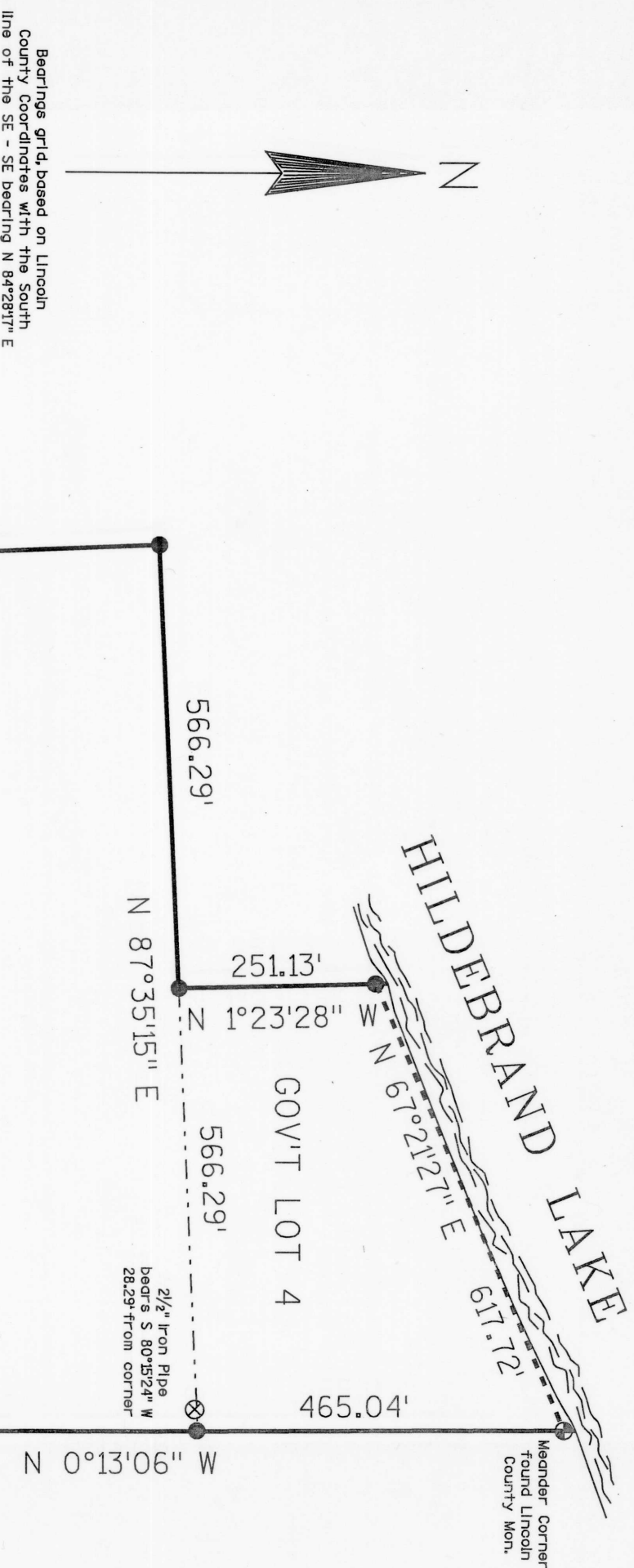


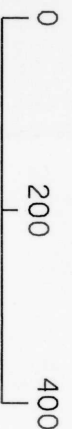
THE SE-SE AND THE EAST HALF OF GOV'T LOT 4,

Parcel Description:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of Section 1, T 35 N, R 8 E, Town of Harrison, Lincoln County, Wisconsin, marked with a 2 1/4" Iron Pipe with a brass cap, said point also being the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence, along the south line of said section 1, S 84°28'17" W for a distance of 1085.62 feet to the Southwest corner of the SE-SE of said section 1, marked with a 1/4" Iron Pipe; thence, along the west line of said SE-SE, N 02°33'50" W for a distance of 1240.93 feet to the Northwest corner of said SE-SE, marked with a 1/4" Iron Pipe; thence, along the north line of said SE-SE, N 87°35'15" E for a distance of 566.29 feet to a 1/4" Iron Pipe; thence N 01°23'28" W for a distance of 251.13 feet to a 1/4" Iron Pipe on the shore of Hildebrand Lake; thence, meandering along the shore of Hildebrand Lake, N 67°21'27" E for a distance of 617.72 feet to the east line of said section 1, marked with a Lincoln County monument; thence, along the east line of said section 1, S 00°13'06" E for a distance of 465.04 feet to the Northeast corner of said SE-SE, marked with a 1/4" Iron Pipe; thence, continuing along the east line of said section 1, S 00°13'06" E for a distance of 1182.78 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.
