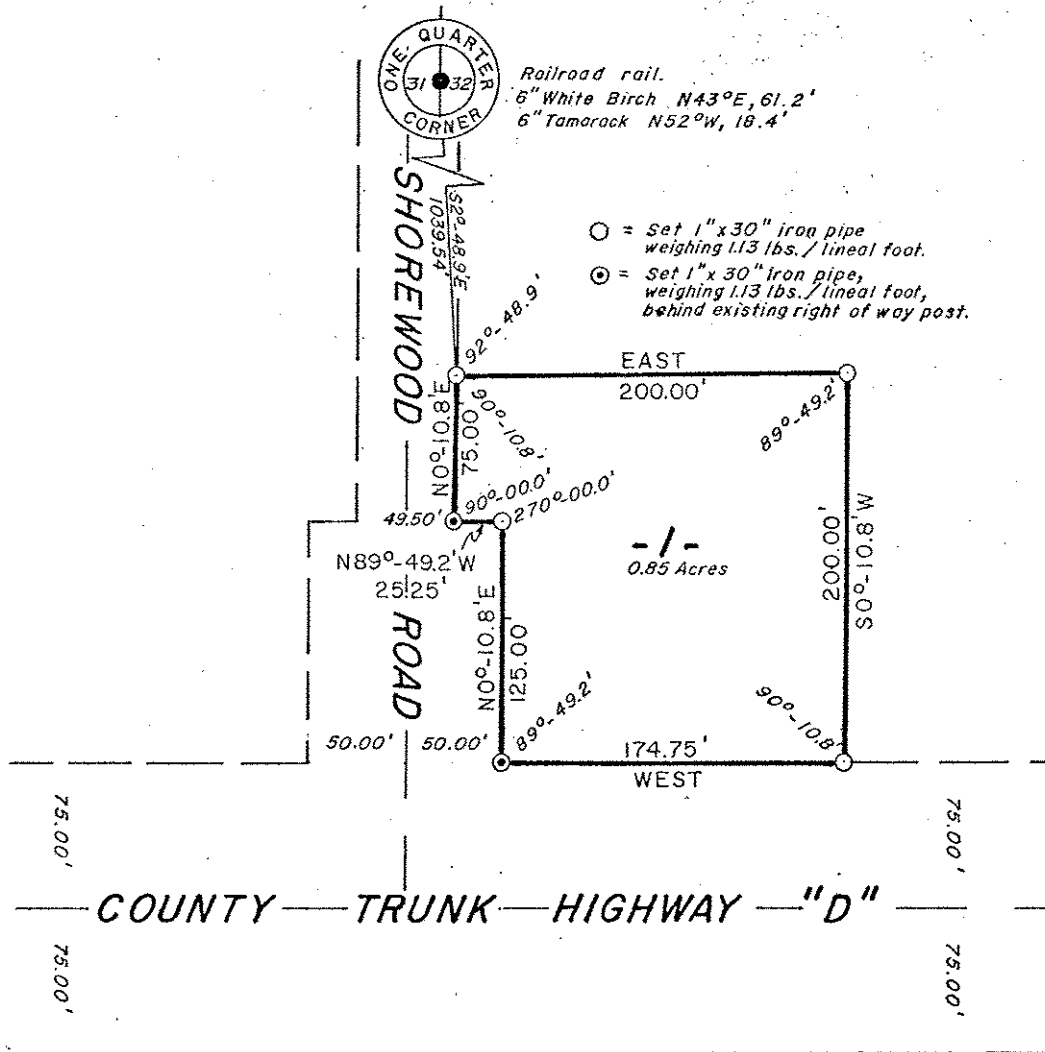

Lot 1, a parcel of land in the NW-1/4 of the SW-1/4, Section 32, T35N, R7E, King Township, Lincoln County, Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the one-quarter corner common to Sections 31 and 32, marked by a railroad rail, witnessed by a 6" Birch bearing N43°E, 61.2 feet and by a 6" Tamarack bearing N52°W, 18.4 feet; thence S2°-48.9'E, 1039.54 feet to the place of beginning, marked by a 1" iron pipe on the easterly right-of-way line of Shorewood Road.

Thence East, 200.00 feet to a 1" iron pipe; thence S0°-10.8'W, 200.00 feet to a 1" iron pipe on the northerly right-of-way line of County Trunk Highway "D"; thence West, 174.75 feet along said right-of-way line to its intersection with the easterly right-of-way line of Shorewood Road, marked by a 1" iron pipe; thence N0°-10.8'E, 75.00 feet along said right-of-way line of Shorewood Road to the place of beginning.
