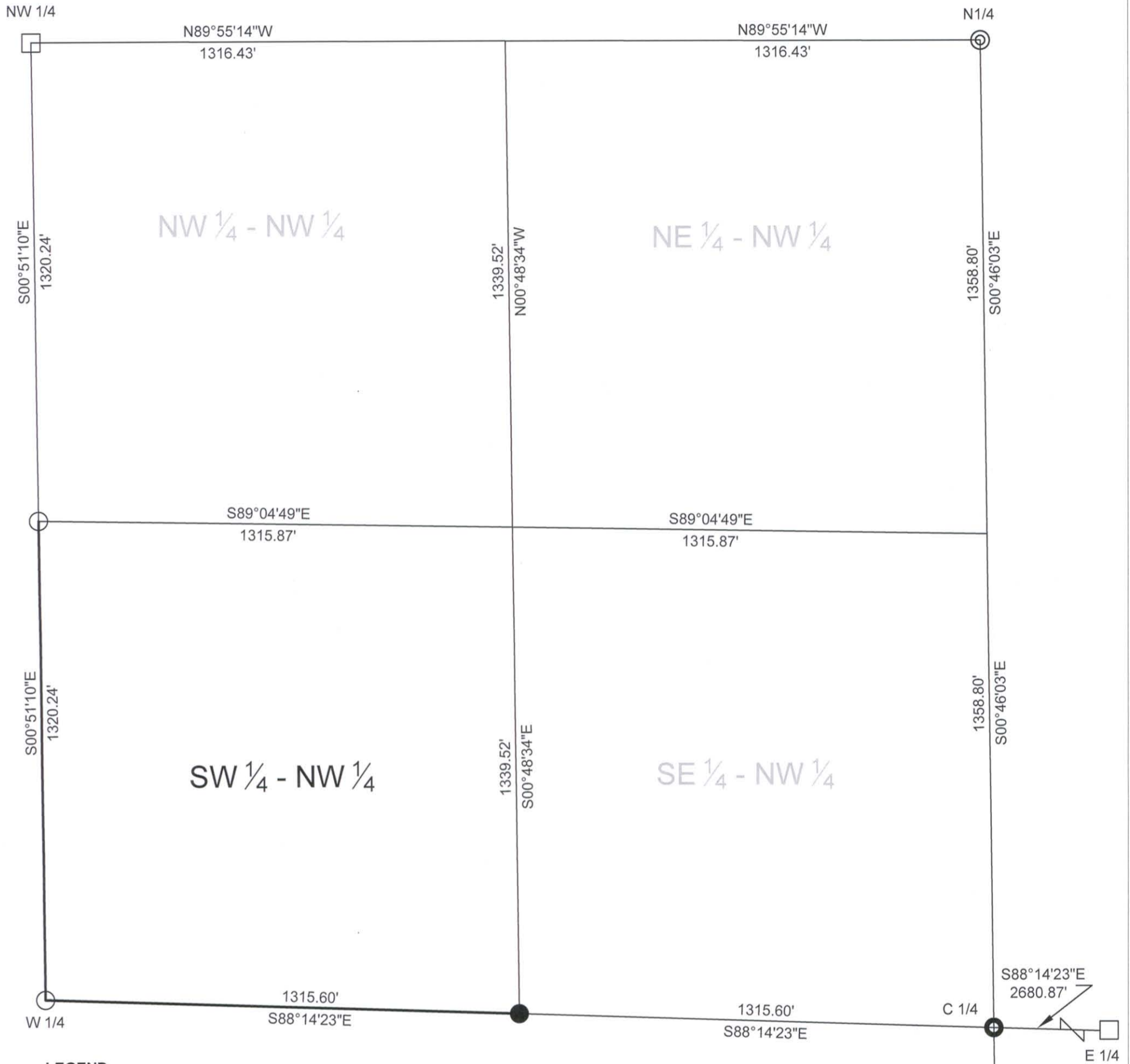


**LINCOLN COUNTY FOREST BOUNDARY LINE

LEGEND

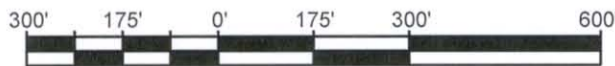
- Found 2.5" Capped Iron Pipe
