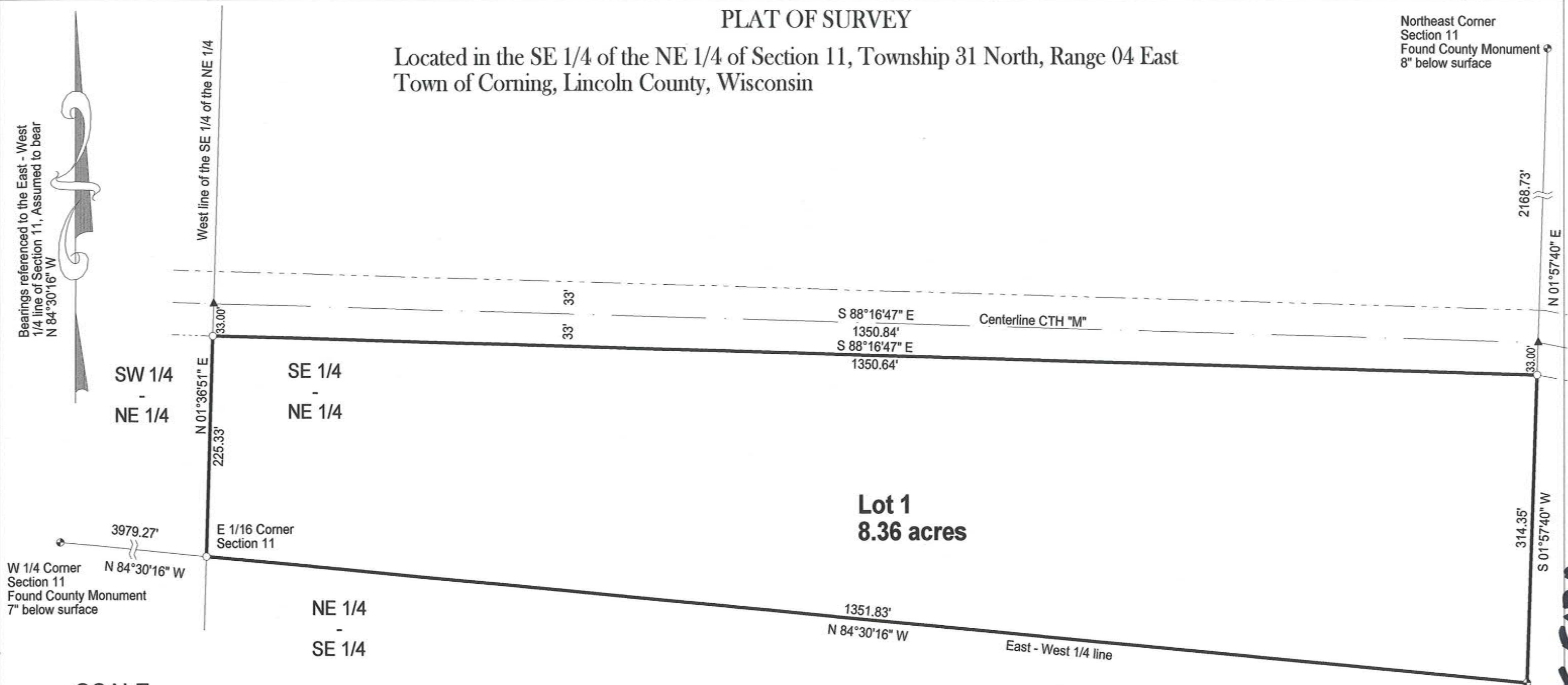


PLAT OF SURVEY

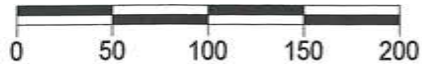
Located in the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 11, Township 31 North, Range 04 East

Lot 1 Description:
That part of the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 11, Township 31 North, Range 04 East, Town of Corning, Lincoln County, Wisconsin lying south of CTH "M". More particularly described as follows:
Commencing at the East quarter corner of said Section 11, marked by a Lincoln County Monument, also being the POINT OF BEGINNING;
thence, along the east - west quarter line, N 84°30'16" W for a distance of 1351.83 feet to the southwest corner of said southeast quarter of the northeast quarter, marked by a 1-inch iron pipe; thence, along the west line of said southeast quarter of the northeast quarter, N 01°36'51" E for a distance of 225.33 feet to the southerly right of way line of CTH "M", marked by a 1-inch iron pipe; thence, along said right of way line, S 88°16'47" E for a distance of 1350.64 feet to the east line of said Section 11, marked by a 1-inch iron pipe; thence, along the east line of said Section 11, S 01°57'40" W for a distance of 314.35 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.
Lot 1 contains approximately 8.26 acres. Along with and subject to any easements, restrictions or reservations apparent or of record.
