
U.S. PUBLIC LAND SURVEY MONUMENT RECORD

If not acceptted or if nothing was found, state evidence used as basis for establishing location. If reestablished through lost corner proportionate methods, indicate all monuments, distances and directions used to establish. Corner was a wood post originally set in March of 1852 by F. S. Ellis with the following witnesses: 14" Hemlock S57°E 17 links, 14" Hemlock N15°W 13 MINIMINIMI links. Corner was re-established by the resurvey of part of the Town of Scott, completed in June, 1903, by L. Kleinschmidt with stone monuments set. I obtained the highway field notes for Division Job No. 7035. Notes show that DAVID J. they did not find the stone monument but held a fence line to the north as GOSLIN evidence of the section line. I proportioned between the South 1/4 Corners of S-2280 WAUSALI Section 8 and 9 as shown on reverse side and set Berntsen Survey Mark nail on centerline of highway per right of way plat. Corner fits highway stationing from MINIMUM CONTRACTOR the existing residence to the west, a power line to the north as being described on the fence line and Section line in Volume 72 page 392 and the 1939 Council Grounds survey distance to the South 1/4 Corner of Section 9. Accepted proportioned location and tied out as shown below. (c) (d) (e) Plan view of corner with ties to at least 4 witness monuments. 
