

Description of corner evidence found:

We found a 6"x6" granite monument at the intersection of the centerlines of Scott Road and School Avenue, it was buried 11" under the road surface. The stone was the same type as we've found in other areas in the Town of Scott. The stone were set in 1903 by Louis Kleinschmidt. His map is on record in the Register of Deeds office in the Lincoln County Courthouse.
