

08/06/1974 - D.T. & D.M., for Mink Capital Surveying, Inc, show on a Survey Monument Location Record that they found 2" Iron Pipe buried 5" below the surface. They made reference ties to perpetuate the corner location.

10/11/1982 - C. Offerman, RLS-926, states that no evidence of the original corner nor it's accessories was found. He found a 2" Iron Pipe at the intersection of a fence north extended south, a fence east extended west, and the centerline of a town road south. It was believed to be the best available evidence and was harmoniously related to existing local conditions. The 2" Iron Pipe was replaced with a standard 30" Berntsen monument. He set reference ties to perpetuate the corner location.

10/09/2014 - I, Anthony R. Dallman, PLS-2405, found the 4" (o.d.) Berntsen Aluminum Monument at the corner location, just below existing grade and ±8' north of edge of gravel road surface, matching two remaining ties. In reviewing other perpetuated monument material in this area of Pine River, and the previously stated fence and centerline evidence, I felt it necessary to search further with the county Gradall at a better intersection of said evidence. I found nothing. I accepted the Berntsen Aluminum Monument as marking the perpetuated corner location. I set new reference ties and remeasured the existing ties to further perpetuate the corner location, as shown in the sketch below.


