

Description of corner evidence found:

I used a fence line running East and West for North, South position and a line between the Northeast and Southeast corners of Section 30 for East, West line because it fit the road centerline reasonably well. We excavated the road in this area with a backhoe below the original grade and found no evidence of a corner.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

We set a Lincoln County Berntsen Monument having the following witness monuments:

1 1/4" x 30" solid round iron rod set approximately 1' West of 2" blazed Norway Pine bearing N32°E, 57.98' 1 1/4" x 30" solid round iron rod set approximately 1' West of a 8" blazed

Poplar bearing S39°E, 47.25'

1 1/4" x 30" solid round iron rod set approximately 1' East of a 5" blazed Maple bearing S34°W, 61.86'

1" iron pipe found in place approximately 1' West of end fence post bearing S86°W. 34.70'
