

A 6" x 6" red granite monument was found in place.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

We set the following witness monuments to the monument described above:
Aluminum cap in concrete set as bench mark by Dept. of Natural Resources bearing \$10°W, 9.03'

1 1/4" x 30" solid round iron rod set 1' southerly of 12" maple bearing N72°E, 8.78'

1 1/4" x 30" solid round iron rod set between two 7" poplars bearing N55°E, 36.12'

1 1/4" x 30" solid round iron rod set 1' southerly of three 4" maples, bearing N14°E, 21.70'
