

Description of corner evidence found:

After checking with the Highway Dept. and finding there was no evidence of a corner when C.T.H. "K" was rebuilt in 1971, I decided to use an existing P.K. which was found in the centerline of the road, on line with a fence to the west. This nail was set by the Highway Dept. and has also been used by several previous surveyors in the area.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

We set a Lincoln County Berntsen monument with the following witness monuments: 1 1/4" x 30"iron pipe set 3' east of power pole No. 3106-2R12 bearing, West, 45.71
1 1/4" x 30" iron pipe set 3' west of power pole No. 3106-1L10 bearing, East, 42.95
1 1/4" x 30" iron pipe set in centerline of C.T.H. "K" South, 55.93'
1 1/4" x 30" iron pipe set in centerline of C.T.H. "K" North, 62.92'
