We dug the intersection with a backhoe and found a 6x6x15 inch granite monument. Although the stone did not appear to have been broken we searched for a base anyway. We found none. The stone was found in an upright position about .4 feet below grade. An erroneous l" iron pipe was also found l or 2 feet West of the stone. The pipe was badly bent. We set a .75"x30" iron rod on north side of the stone. Louis Kleinschmidt originally set the stone in 1903. His map is on record at the Lincoln County Register of Deeds Office.
