

THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 13 FALLS IN THE WISCONSIN RIVER. I MEASURED EXTENSIVELY THROUGHOUT SECTION 12 TO THE NORTH. THE CORNERS ALONG THE NORTH LINE OF THIS SECTION ARE IN AND ARE ACCEPTED. THE MAIN EVIDENCE LEFT OF THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER ARE THE CENTERLINES OF STREETS THROUGHOUT THIS SECTION WHICH GENERALLY FALL ALONG 1/16TH LINES. I FOUND THAT THE LOCATION OF THESE CENTERLINES FIT VERY WELL TO EACH OTHER AS WELL AS THE ORIGINAL GOVERNMENT SURVEY OF SECTION 12. I ALSO MEASURED TO A FOUND STONE AT THE ACCEPTED CENTER OF SECTION 13 TO THE SOUTH, AS WELL AS THE CENTERLINE OF O'DAY STREET IN SECTION 13. O'DAY STREET FALLS ALONG THE SOUTH LINE OF THE NORTH 1/2 OF GOVERNMENT LOT 4 (NW1/4-NE1/4) OF SECTION 13. I ACCEPTED THE THE CENTERLINE OF CENTER AVENUE FROM THE NORTH AS THE EAST & WEST LOCATION OF THE CORNER. I HELD THE FOUND STONE AT THE CENTER OF SECTION 13 AND THE CENTERLINE OF O'DAY STREET AND DOUBLED THE DISTANCE BETWEEN THE TWO TO DETERMINE THE NORTH & SOUTH LOCATION OF THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 12. I THEN SET A MEANDER CORNER TO THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER AS SHOWN BELOW.
