

Originally Surveyed in 1852 by Albert Ellis and Fredrick Ellis. Original corner was a wooden post


with bearing trees: 18" Birch E, 29 lks 20" Linn Elm S52'W, 6 lks.

Revisited by Sheridan D. Schwark on November 2, 1980 where he found a 6"x 6" Red Granite Manument with witness to a 7/8" Iran Rod N48 $^\circ$ E, 22.34 feet; o P.K. nail in a 30" Pine 514 $^\circ$ W, 23.75 feet; and also a 3/4" x Iran Rod N32 $^\circ$ W, 13.89 feet.

Description of corner evidence found:

We found the $6" \times 6"$ Red Granite Stone along an old downed North-South fenceline and a downed East fenceline. We accepted this position and tied to 7/8" Rebars with Lincoln County Caps.
