

03/07/2006 - K. Walkowski, PLS-2717, found the Granite Stone during a remonumentation project for Lincoln County, shown on Lincoln County Surveyor's Office Map No. L423.


11/27/12 - I, Anthony R. Dallman, PLS-2405, found the 6" x 6" Granite Stone Monument, protruding 4" above grade, with a 3/4" Iron Rod along the north edge. The Stone is located in an east-west fenceline with a fence post lying 0.9' west of Stone. I set new reference ties and remeasured an existing tie to further perpetuate the corner location, as shown in the sketch below.
