

08/13/1979 - S. Schwark, RLS-1205, found a Stone Monument when excavating roadway, down about 5 feet below grade, broken and tipped. He removed the Stone and replaced it with a Lincoln Count Berntsen Monument. He set new reference ties and remeasured an existing tie to perpetuate the corner location.

10/31/2012 - I, Anthony R. Dallman, PLS-2405, found the top of the Berntsen Aluminum Monument broken off below the road surface. The remaining portion of the Aluminum Monument base remains intact, down ±16" below the road surface. I set one new reference tie and remeasured the existing ties to further perpetuate the corner location, as shown in the sketch below.
