

April 21, 2003 — Gene J. Wadzinski shows he found a P.K. Naîl at the corner location per Certified Survey Map Number 1685



We reestablished the corner using the 1 reference monument and found monuments from Certified Survey Map Number 842. We set a survey nail stamped "SURVEY MARK" and set new reference monuments as shown on Sheet 2 hereof.


