

History of original corner establishment:

Original U.S. government survey conducted in year 1852-53 with wooden posts set for section and quarter corners. Subsequently, 6"x6"x36" red granite stone monuments were set during a remonumentation survey of later date (year unknown).

Description of corner evidence found:

Recovered a 6"x6" granite stone with cross about 10 inches below roadway surface. Set a 3/4"x7" rebar atop center of stone to aid future location.
