

6/1/1995 Chet Nowaczyk dug for corner and found an existing 6" X 6" quarried granite stone similar to the one found by A.B. Kiedrowski at the SE corner of Sec 36, T31N R8E. He set an iron along the east side of stone to to aid in future detection.

10/28/2019 I visited corner and found the granite stone 22" below the surface of gravel road as described by Nowaczyk as well as a 1.25" Iron Pipe on the east side to aid in detection. I found existing ties and set new ties as shown below.




