

Found a 3/4" iron pipe next to 3" cedar post lying down with scribes on it that were to weathered to read. Replaced iron pipe with Bernsten monument and set (4) 7/8" rebar with Lincoln County caps as witness monuments approx. 2 feet from bearing trees.
