

09/30/2010: I FOUND NO EVIDENCE OF THE ORIGINAL CORNER OR ACCESSORIES. I SET A LINCOLN COUNTY ALUMINUM SWAMP MONUMENT AT THE PROPORTIONED LOCATION, MADE FOUR BEARING TREES AND SET A WHITE PLASTIC POST 1' NORTH. THERE IS A 2" DIA. IRON PIPE 20+/- NORTH OF THE CORNER WITH A BLAZE LINE RUNNING EAST AND SOUTH FROM IT. ACCORDING TO THE ADJACENT PROPERTY OWNERS, THE LINES WERE MARKED BY A FORESTER AND THE PIPE WAS SET BY THE PROPERTY OWNERS AFTER THE LINES WERE

(c)(d)(e) PLAN VIEW OF CORNER WITH TIES TO AT LEAST FOUR WITNESSES. IF IN DISAGREEMENT WITH PREVIOUSLY ESTABLISHED CORNER, SHOW THE DISTANCES BETWEEN THE TWO CORNERS AND ALSO INDICATE THE TIE TO THE DISPUTED CORNER.
