

ORIGINAL CORNER SET IN NOVEMBER, 1852, BY RICK CHANEY. DAVID AMENT, LOCAL LAND OWNER, SAID THAT IN THE 40'S, A LARGE FOREST FIRE BURNT EVERYTHING IN THIS TOWNSHIP. THERE ARE NO LARGE STUMPS IN THIS SECTION. FOUND NO EVIDENCE OF ORIGINAL TIES OR ORIGINAL WOOD POST.

DAVID AMENT, LONG TIME RESIDENT TOLD US OF THIS CORNER LOCATION. HE FELT THE EXISTING 1" IRON PIPE WAS THE SECTION CORNER. TRAVERSED TO AREA, FOUND 3/4" IRON PIPE. DID NOT FIT SECTION AMENT SAID CORNER WAS A 1" IRON PIPE. AFTER FURTHER SEARCH FOUND 1" X 4' IRON PIPE. HELD AS CORNER. SET BERNSTEN MONUMENT WITH FIBERGLASS WARNING SIGN.

(c) (d) (e) PLAN VIEW OF CORNER WITH TIES TO AT LEAST 4 WITNESS MONUMENTS. IF IN DISAGREEMENT WITH PREVIOUSLY ESTABLISHED CORNER, SHOW THE DISTANCES BETWEEN THE TWO CORNERS AND ALSO INDICATE THE TIES TO THE DISPUTED CORNER.
