Description of corner evidence found:

I set the corner by proportionate methods because the only evidence available was a fence line which was discredited by an elderly resident.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

We set a Lincoln County Berntsen Monument having the following witness monuments:

1 1/4" x 30" solid round iron rod set approximately 2' Southwest of blacktop edge of S.T.H. "107" bearing N38°E, 84.56'

1 1/4" x 30" solid round iron rod set approximately 3' South of power pole bearing S67°E, 42.96'

1 1/4" x 30" solid round iron rod set approximately 2' North of 3" Norway Pine bearing S9°E, 70.55'

1 1/4" x 30" solid round iron rod set approximately 2' North of 3" Norway Pine bearing S28°W, 74.31'
