



Description of corner evidence found:

We excavated in the area of intersecting centerlines of a road running south and east from the corner, and in the area of intersecting f/lines from the north and west, and found nothing. Because the roads and fences could not be used to arrive at any single location, I felt that they were very poor evidence to use to establish a corner. Therefore, I set this corner using a single proportionate method between the N.W. and N.E. corners.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

We set a Lincoln County Berntsen monument with the following witness monuments: 1 1/4" x 30" iron pipe set 3' north of iron fence post, bearing S38°E, 80.32' 1 1/4" x 30" iron pipe set at the north edge of blacktop road, bearing S76°E, 75.76' 1 1/4" x 30" iron pipe set in the east edge of form road bearing N10°W, 49.58' 1 1/4" x 30" iron pipe set 3' east of power pole No. 3206-34L9, bearing S85°W, 51.20'
