## CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RESTORATION

History of original corner establishment:

Description of corner evidence found:

We excavated Heineman Road with a backhoe ( A. Wyland operator ) and found a red granite monument broken into two pieces. The top portion measured 7"x7"xll". We removed the base portion of the stone, which was upright and in good condition. It measured 7"x7"x20". We found it about 18" below grade and about 4' North of existing centerline of the granite road.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner. We set a Lincoln County Berntsen Monument in the position of the base portion of the stone.
