

-2009- Kevin Bixby found two iron rod witnesses by Schwark and set a Lincoln County





We excavated the blacktop road at the intersection of the two centerlines, Jack Prueser backhoe operator, and found a 6" x 6" red granite monument about 2 feet below the surface. The monument was tipped northeasterly. We replaced the monument with a Lincoln County Berntsen monument and established the references as shown below.
