

1941 - Francis X. Fox survey for the Town of Rock Falls, in surveying North between Sections 33 and 34, at 2645.9 feet, to old stake and set 1/4 stone. Bearing tree 13" Birch, N34°W, 20.6 feet, East 50 feet to centerline of road, mounded with stone.

11/10/2017, I visited corner location and found a 6" x 6" square black granite stone set by fox in 1941 approximately 50 west of centerline of road. Accepted as correct, and set four ties as measured and shown below. There was an existing fencepost to the north of the stone and I set a vinyl "T" post to the west of the stone.
