
07/02/1971 - W. Scherer, Surveyor, Wisconsin Division of Highways, Project I.D. 1173-5-00, found two (2) 1.5" Iron Rod reference monuments, painted yellow, from a previous highway project. Set a P.K. Nail in the road at a mid-point (50' north & south) from each Iron Rod.

05/03/2005 - M. Oestreich, PLS-2118, recovered the two (2) Iron Rods and set a Berntsen Survey Marker Nail at a mid-point between them. He set additional reference ties to perpetuate the corner location.

06/01/2015 - I, Anthony R. Dallman, PLS-2405, visited corner prior to road resurfacing. I found the existing Berntsen Survey Marker Nail and reference ties intact.

10/21/2015 - I, Anthony R. Dallman, PLS-2405, set a Berntsen Survey Marker Nail at the intersection of existing reference ties as shown in the sketch below.



Department of Transportation: 7/2/71, recovered two 1.5" dia. iron rods painted yellow and set a P.K. Nail in pavement of Highway "J" midway between iron rods for North Quarter Corner of Section 17. The distance from P.K. Nail set to the iron rod to the north is 50.0' & the distance to the iron rod to the south is 50.0'. They note the P.K. Nail is 0.7' north of the centerline of County Trunk Highway "J".

Michael L. Oestreich: 5/3/05, recovered two 1.5" dia. iron rods painted yellow, and set a survey marker nail midpoint between the iron rods. The survey marker nail is 0.5' north of the centerline of County Trunk Highway "J". I then made witness ties as shown in plan below.
