

Description of corner evidence found:

We searched at the intersection of the centerline of Yanda Avenue and an old North - South fenceline with a backhoe operated by Arnold Wyland Jr. We found a 7" x 7" x 29" granite stone with an irregular shaped top somewhat west of the fenceline and very close to the road centerline. We removed the granite and replaced it with a Lincoln County Berntsen monument.
