

Description of corner evidence found: I found no evidence of either the corner or the original bearing tress or their stumps. Original notes call for the south line of the section to be 5273.40'. A resurvey of this south line, I find the distance to be 5264.50'. I therefore set a Lincoln County Berntsen Monument on a straight line at 2632.25' from the Southeast and Southwest corners of Section 16.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner. 30" Berntsen monument top is set 3" above surface of ground.
