



12/11/2010: I FOUND A RAILROAD SPIKE 4" BELOW GRADE AT THE CENTERLINE INTERSECTION OF TWO TOWN ROADS. I HELD THE RAILROAD SPIKE AS THE BEST AVAILABLE EVIDENCE AND SET FOUR 3/4" DIA. CAPPED REBAR REFERENCE MONUMENTS AS SHOWN BELOW.
