

Description of corner evidence found: Found a 1½" 2 3.5' iron pipe for the corner.

A 5" x 5" squared wood post is just to the north of the corner. A fence line from the west ends at the corner. Witnesses: 7" cedar, S 62° E, 11.24' 11" cedar, S 79° W, 13.94'

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

Replaced iron pipe with Berntsen monument for corner, mounded with sand.
