


Description of corner evidence found: The East 1/4 corner was called for being in the bed of State Trunk Highway "17". There is a large scale reconstruction of the highway's grade going on. The area under the highway's new bed was scraped by a road grader 3" to 5" cuts to uncover evidence of the granite monument set by Francis Fox in 1937. After excavating to a depth of 3.5' below the old road surface and to the edge of the detour road, at which point the contractor indicated that he would get in touch with me when the new surface is in use and the detour area could be searched. To this point, he has not contacted me. I expect to complete the area to be searched in 1983, at which time I will file a second form.
