

05/24/2018, I, Anthony R. Dallman, PLS-2405, found the 6"  $\times$  6" Granite Monument at the corner location, protruding  $\pm$ 20" above the ground surface and leaning Westerly. Removed the Granite, dug a deeper hole at the base and reset the Granite plumb and mounded with stone. The Granite is now  $\pm$ 1' above ground. I set new reference ties to further perpetuate the corner location, as shown in the sketch below.
