

Nowlin, set wood post for corner with bearings, white pine 10 S50° W 15 links and hemlock 12 S 46° E 17 links. I found no evidence of the corner or witnesses at or near the corner. Keg Road has a large fill at the corner location. This made it not possible to excavate for evidence of the corner. I used the witness of Jacob VanRyen, a life long resident, who lives just to the northwest of the corner location. He indicated the old fence line to the west being extended easterly to the centre-line of Keg Road is where he feels the corner was many year ago. I set a Berntser Keg Road is where he feels the corner was many year ago. I set a Berntsen monument at this location for the corner and witnessed as shown below.
